

Message from the Town Council Chairman

Over the years, we have all witnessed the transformation of the Pasir Ris - Punggol landscape and how it has evolved into a vibrant and dynamic community for our residents.

At Pasir Ris, residents will be welcoming many new additions and enhancements to their estates in the next 5 to 10 years. With improvements to be rolled out progressively under the Remaking Our Heartland programme, residents can envisage a revamped and reinvigorated urban sanctuary to call their own. As announced by Prime Minister Lee Hsien Loong during the National Day Rally 2018, the Home Improvement Programme (HIP) will be expanded to include HDB blocks built in the years up to 1997, thus benefiting our home-owners in Pasir Ris. The programme helps flat owners deal with common maintenance problems (e.g. spalling concrete and ceiling leaks) related to ageing flats.

You may already know that Punggol has several new developments such as Punggol Digital District and the upcoming residential district at Punggol Point in the pipeline. With these plans in place, residents can look forward to new retail amenities, more community and recreation facilities and exciting job opportunities close to In tandem with new housing plans, more amenities will be provided to ensure a comfortable living environment for Sengkang residents. For one, the Sengkang General and Community Hospitals which opened in August 2018 provides residents with more convenient access to medical

With the intention to improve connectivity for our residents, several developments such as a new road interchange linking Punggol and Pasir Ris will be ready by next year, a new road interchange at Tampines Expressway and Seletar Link will be built by 2021, and a new Punggol Coast MRT station ready by 2023.

Following the General Election in 2015, we welcome Punggol East SMC back into our Pasir Ris - Punggol family. There are now more childcare centres to meet the needs of younger families. New and upgraded playgrounds, adult and elderly fitness corners, as well as community gardens are being completed progressively, with more coming your way. Residents of all ages can look forward to an active lifestyle and foster greater community bonding while enjoying the facilities.

Aside from improved infrastructural developments and facilities, we also believe in doing our part for the environment through energy conservation. We started changing light fixtures in our town to LED lights progressively to reduce energy consumption. Not only these LED lights are brighter, they provide better illumination for residents. By the end of this year, all existing blocks including car parks across all divisions of Pasir Ris -Punggol GRC and Punggol East SMC will be installed with

While we strive for improvement and the betterment of our community, we will continue to maintain active engagement with you. Let us all work together to make our Town an even better home for

Mesej dari Pengerusi Majlis Bandaran

Selama beberapa tahun, kami telah menyaksikan transformasi landskap Pasir Ris-Punggol dan perkembangan dari segi suasana masyarakat yang kini semakin bertenaga dan dinamik.

Dalam tempoh 5 hingga 10 tahun akan datang, para penduduk Pasir Ris berpeluang menikmati lebih banyak kemudahan awam yang baharu serta penambahbaikan estet-estet di sini.Penambahan ini akan dilaksanakan secara berperingkat di bawah program "Pembentukan Semula Estet Perumahan Kita" (Remaking Our Heartland Programmme).

Semasa Ucapan Rapat Hari Kebangsaan 2018, Perdana Menteri Lee Hsien Loong mengatakan bahawa Program Peningkatan Rumah (HIP) akan diperluas untuk meliputi blok-blok HDB yang dibina sehingga tahun 1997. Program in akan bermanfaat kepada penduduk Pasir Ris. Program ini juga akan membantu para pemilik rumah untuk menangani masalah penyelenggaraan seperti keretakan konkrit dan

Anda mungkin sudah ketahui bahawa Punggol mempunyai beberapa Punggol District dan juga Digital Punggol District yang masih lagi dalam perancangan. Dengan itu, penduduk boleh menantikan lebih banyak kemudahan baharu seperti tempat rekreasi, kedai-kedai dan lain-lain lagi yang juga dapat menawarkan peluang pekerjaan yang menarik yang berdekatan

Kemudahan-kemudahan ini akan memastikan persekitaran hidup yang selesa untuk penduduk Sengkang. Lebih-lebih lagi Hospital Besar dan Rumah Sakit Masyarakat Sengkang yang telah dibuka pada Ogos 2018 yang menyediakan akses kepada perkhidmatan perubatan untuk para penduduk dengan lebih mudah.

Dari segi memudahkan perjalanan dari satu destinasi ke satu destinasi, terdapat beberapa pembinaan lebuh raya baharu yang menghubungkan Punggol dan Pasir Ris yang akan siap pada tahun hadapan. Pembinaan sebuah persimpangan jalan baharu di Tampines Expressway dan Seletar Link akan dibina menjelang 2021 dan stesen MRT Punggol Coast akan siap pada 2023.

Berikutan daripada pilihan raya umum Singapura 2015, kami mangalu-alukan pihak SMC Punggol East kembali bersama kami di Pasir Ris-Punggol. Kini, terdapat lebih banyak pusat penjagaan kanakkanak untuk memenuhi keperluan keluarga muda. Lebih banyak taman permainan baharu, sudut kecergasan dewasa dan warga tua serta taman-taman rekreasi sedang disiapkan secara berperingkat. Penduduk daripada semua peringkat umur boleh mengamalkan gaya

hidup yang sihat dan memupuk ikatan masyarakat yang lebih erat sambil menikmati kemudahan tersebut.

Selain daripada pembinaan infrastruktur dan kemudahan yang dipertingkatkan, kami juga melaksanakan kewajipan kami dalam memelihara alam sekitar melalui pemuliharaan tenaga. Kami telah mula menggantikan lampu di bandar kami kepada lampu LED secara beransur-ansur untuk mengurangkan penggunaan tenaga. Lampu-lampu LED ini bukan sahaja lebih terang malah telah menyediakan pencahayaan yang lebih baik untuk penduduk. Menjelang akhir tahun ini, semua blok termasuk tempat meletak kereta di semua bahagian Pasir Ris-Punggol GRC dan Punggol East SMC akan dipasang dengan lampu LED.

Dalam usaha kami untuk mencapai peningkatan dan kebaikan, kami akan terus mengekalkan hubungan proaktif bersama para penduduk. Marilah kami menggembleng bahu untuk menjadikan bandar kami sebuah estet yang lebih baik untuk semua.

多年来,我们一同见证了我们市镇的蜕变,看着它成为了居民朝 气蓬勃、充满活力的家园。

巴西立的居民将在未来5到10年内看到该社区有更多的更新及 邻区改善工程进行。在"再创我们的家园" (Remaking Our Heartland, 简称ROH) 计划下, 社区将会逐步进行翻新与改 善。居民可期待家园焕然一新,注入新生命,成为都市中的世外 桃源。李显龙总理在2018年的国庆群众大会上宣布,家居改进计划(Home Improvement Programme,简称HIP)的范围即将扩大,把于1997年或以前建成的组屋也纳入计划中。也就是说, 巴西立的居民也在计划下受益,解决屋龄较高的组屋一些常见的 维修问题,例如水泥剥落与漏水的问题。

您或许已经听说,榜鹅本身也将进行多项计划,包括发展榜鹅坊 园区及榜鹅数码园区。计划落成后,居民便可享有更多的购物选择,更多的社区与娱乐设施,以及更多临近住家的工作机会。 新住宅项目落成的同时,我们也将为盛港居民提供更多设施,以便营造更舒适的生活环境。盛港综合医院及社区医院已在2018年8月份开幕,为居民提供更便利的医疗服务。

为了让居民在交通上享有更多便利,多项交通方面的发展计划 将会被逐渐落成。连接榜鹅和巴西立的新道路将于明年竣工。 2021年,连接淡滨尼高速公路和实里达连道的路段也会投入 使用。此外,2023年,全新的榜鹅海岸地铁站即将启用。

在2015年大选之后,我们非常高兴并欢迎榜鹅东单选区重返白沙-榜鹅的大家庭。如今,该社区内已开设了更多的托儿中心以满足年 轻夫妇的需求。区内增设了更多新的儿童游乐场、成人和乐龄健身 设施以及社区花园,现有的设施也得到了更新了。接下来还会有更 多类似的设施逐渐的在区内被建立。各各不同年龄的居民在享用设 施时,不但可以培养活跃的生活习惯以外还能增进与邻居之间的凝

除了改善基础发展与设施外,我们也相信我们能通过节能减碳为 环保尽一份力。我们已经逐步的将区内的电灯改换为LED灯泡, 以节省能源。这些LED灯泡也比传统灯泡更为明亮,能为居民提 供更好的照明。今年年底之前,白沙-榜鹅集选区和榜鹅东单选 区所有组屋,包括停车场,都会装上LED灯泡。

பாசிர் ரிஸ்-பொங்கோல் வட்டாரம் கடந்த சில வருடங்களாக எவ்வாறு மாற்றம் கண்டுள்ளது என்பதையும் அது எப்படி நமது குடியிருப்பாளர்களுக்குத் துடிப்பான சுறுசுறுப்பான சமூகமாக உருவெடுத்தது என்பதையும் நாமெல்லாம் நன்கு அறிவோம்.

குடியிருப்பாளர்கள் பல புதிய மற்றும் மேம்பட்ட வசதிகளை அடுத்த 5 – 10 வருடங்களில் பாசிர் ரிஸ்ஸில் எதிர்பார்க்கலாம். நமது வட்டாரத்தை மறுஉருவாக்கும் திட்டத்தின் கீழ் படிப்படியாக மேம்பாடுகள் செய்யப்படும். இது நமது குடியிருப்பாளர்களுக்கு மறுசீரமைக்கப்பட்ட புத்தாக்கமிகு நகர வாழ்கையை வழங்கும். நமது பிரதமர் லீ சியன் லூங் அவர்கள் 2018 தேசிய தின பேரணியில் அறிவித்தது போன்று வீட்டு மேம்பாட்டுத் திட்டம் (HIP) 1997 வரை கட்டப்பட்ட வீடுகளையும் உள்ளடக்கும் வகையில் விரிவாக்கப்படும். இதனால், நமது பாசிர் ரிஸ் வீட்டு உரிமையாளர்களும் பயனடைவர். பழமையான வீடுகளில் ஏற்படும் பொதுவான பராமரிப்பு பிரச்சனைகளை (எ.கா. கீழ்விழும் கான்கிரீட்டுகள் மற்றும் கூறா கசிவ) வீட்டு உரிமையாளர்களு . கான்கிரீட்டுகள் மற்றும் கூரை கசிவு) வீட்டு உரிமையாளர்கள் சமாளிக்க இத்திட்டம் உதவும்.

பொங்கோல் டிஜிட்டல் டிஸ்ட்ரிக் மற்றும் ார். பாய்ன்ட்டில் வரவிருக்கும் குடியிருப்பு வட்டாரம் போன்ற பல புதிய கட்டுமானங்கள் பொங்கோல் வட்டாரத்தில் திட்டமிடப்பட்டுள்ளதை நீங்கள் அனைவரும் ஏற்கனவே அறிந்திருப்பீர்கள். இத்திட்டங்கள் நிறைவுறும்போது வசிப்பிடத்திற்கு அருகிலேயே பல சில்லறை வர்த்தகக்கூடங்களையும், அதிகமான சமூக மற்றும் விளையாட்டு வசதிகளையும், வேலை வாய்ப்புகளையும் குடியிருப்பாளர்கள்

புதிய குடியிருப்புத் திட்டங்களின் அடிப்படையில் செங்காங் குடியிருப்பாளர்களுக்கு வசதியான குடியிருப்புச் சூழலை உறுதிசெய்யும் வகையில் அதிகமான வசதிகள் செய்து தரப்படும். முதலாவதாக, ஆகஸ்டு 2018–ல் திறக்கப்பட்ட செங்காங் பொது மற்றும் சமூக மருத்துவமனைகள் குடியிருப்பாளர்களுக்கு மிகவும் வசதியாக அருகிலேயே மருத்துவ சேவைகளை வழங்குகிறது.

நமது குடியிருப்பாளர்களுக்குப் போக்குவரத்துத் தொடர்பை மேம்படுத்தும் வகையில் அடுத்த ஆண்டு பொங்கோல் மற்றும் பாசிர் ரிஸையும் இணைக்கும் புதிய சாலைச் சந்திப்பும், 2021 – ல் தெம்பனீஸ் விரைவுச்சாலை மற்றும் சிலேடார் லிங்கையும் இணைக்கும் புதிய சாலைச் சந்திப்பும், 2023 –ல் புதிய பொங்கோல் கோஸ்ட் MRT நிலையம் போன்ற பல மேம்பாடுகள் தயாராகிவிடும்.

பொதுத் தேர்தல் 2015 –யை தொடர்ந்து பாசிர் ரிஸ் - பொங்கோல் குடும்பத்திற்கு பொங்கோல் கிழக்கு SMC –யை மீண்டும் நாம் வரவேற்றோம். இளைய குடும்பங்களின் தேவையைப் பூர்த்திசெய்யத் தற்போது அதிகமான குழந்தைப் பராமரிப்பு மையங்கள் உள்ளன. புதிய மற்றும் மேம்படுத்தப்பட்ட விளையாட்டு மைதானங்கள், பெரியவர் மற்றும் முதியவர்களுக்கான உடற்பயிற்சிக் கூடங்கள், சமூகத் தோட்டங்கள் எனப் படிப்படியாக நிறைவு செய்யப்படுகின்றன. இன்னும் பல உங்களுக்கு

இந்த வசதிகளை அனுபவிக்கும் போது வாவிருக்கின்றன. அனைத்து வயதினரும் சுறுசுறுப்பான வாழ்க்கை முறையையும் சிறப்பான சமூகப் பிணைப்பையும் எதிர்பார்க்கலாம்.

மேம்படுத்தப்பட்ட கட்டமைப்புகள் மற்றும் வசதிகளுடன் மைப்படுத்தப்பட்ட கட்டணப்புகள் மற்றும் வசத்களுடன் மின்சக்தி சேமிப்பின் மூலம் சுற்றுச் சூழலை பாதுகாப்பதற்கான முயற்சியையும் நாங்கள் மேற்கொள்கிறோம். மின்சக்தி பயனீட்டை குறைக்கும் வகையில் நமது வட்டாரத்திலுள்ள விளக்குகளை LED விளக்குகளாகப் படிப்படியாக மாற்றி வருகிறோம். இந்த LED விளக்குகள் பளிச்சென ஒளிர்வதுடன் மட்டுமல்லாமல் குடியிருப்பாளர்களுக்கு மேம்பட்ட மட்டுமல்லாமல் குடியிருப்பாளர்களுக்கு மேம்பட்ட வெளிச்சத்தையும் வழங்குகின்றன. இந்த ஆண்டு இறுதிக்குள் பாசிர் ரிஸ் - பொங்கோல் GRC மற்றும் பொங்கோல் கிழக்கு SMC–ல் உள்ள கார் நிறுத்துமிடங்கள் உட்பட அனைத்து வட்டார புளோக்குகளிலும் LED விளக்குகள் பொருத்தப்படும்.



PASIR RIS TOWN

As part of the makeover that the Housing & Development Board has conceived for Pasir Ris, residents can expect plenty of new upgrades to their estates.

In January 2018, the long-awaited Pasir Ris Central Hawker Centre opened its doors to the public. The dual-concept hawker centre offers traditional and hipster cuisine at affordable prices, with a touch of the arts and music. Two family-friendly dining areas have also been completed. The design of the hawker centre aims to provide a creative space for selected aspiring hawkers under the hawker-preneurship programme to set up stalls at a lower cost. White Sands, refurbished in May 2016, now houses a plethora of dining and retail options.

With the Remaking Our Heartland programme now underway, residents will soon be able to embrace a reinvigorated urban sanctuary as their home. At the Pasir Ris Town Centre, a mixeduse development with retail and residential units will be built. It will be integrated with a new bus interchange to provide seamless connection to public transport services and a wide range of commercial facilities, all under one roof. Both Pasir Ris West Plaza and Elias Mall will be upgraded under the programme, with improvements ranging from enhanced play facilities to new seating areas. In addition, five out of seven neighbourhood parks in Pasir Ris will receive a facelift, with the injection of new multigenerational facilities and enhanced landscaping.

With these exciting plans underway, we will continue to strive for quality living for you and your family, and create a home that brings all of us together.

The continual improvement of our Town has always been one of our top priorities as we strive to build a more comfortable home for our residents. Various projects and improvement works are being carried out to bring greater convenience to all.

The completion of the widening of Loyang Avenue from TPE to Pasir Ris Drive 3 has provided residents with greater convenience for their daily commute. With the traffic bottleneck situations occurring during peak hours

eased, residents can now enjoy shorter travelling

times and smoother rides to their destinations.

Under the Selective Lift Replacement programme, old lifts were replaced with modern ones which come with more energy-efficient motors and motion safety sensors for added efficiency and security.

The upgrading works at Loyang Point were completed recently. Our residents can now enjoy sheltered linkways, more parking spaces and a wider variety of shopping and dining options. The mall's upgraded facilities include family-friendly features in its restrooms, 2 new lifts and escalators, and a wider air-conditioned atrium to accommodate more visitors for roadshows, fairs or exhibitions that may be held.

Cyclists and pedestrians can also look forward to more car-free pathways under the Remaking Our Heartland programme. The 1.2km Central Greenway connecting Tampines Eco Green to Pasir Ris Park will run through the town centre and along housing developments. Additional spaces and parks will also be set aside for social activities to allow for more community bonding among residents.

We hope our residents will take pride in living together and create lasting memories as a harmonious community.

NEIGHBOURHOOD RENEWAL PROGRAMME (NRP)

Working hand in hand, the Town Council and HDB bring the NRP to the eligible precincts in Pasir Ris – Punggol.

The NRP aims to upgrade the living environment with the input of the residents of that precinct. Residents are encouraged to provide their feedback on the proposed plan and give their approval of the project via the two rounds of feedback gathering.

In the first phase, the Public Consultation, a minimum of 50% is required for the project to move on to the second phase, the Consensus Gathering. During the second phase, the residents are once again invited to provide their comments on the plan that has

been revised with feasible comments provided by residents in the first phase. All in all, a total of 75% consensus from eligible residents is required for the programme to proceed.

Some of the enhanced neighbourhood facilities residents can look forward to include new linkways, drop-off porches and enhanced landscapes. The cost of the NRP will be fully funded by the government and residents need not pay for the programme.

SENGKANG TOWN

Over the last few years, we have focused on integrating the infrastructure development in Sengkang Central with better programmes to meet your needs, creating a more caring, cohesive and vibrant community.

For our younger residents, we have study areas at Sengkang Community Club (SKCC) and the Residents' Committee (RCs). The study area at SKCC is open for 24 hours with refreshments provided. We will be expanding this service to more locations across the constituency.

For our working adults, we have started Workspace to provide the convenience of having an office space, meeting room and printing services at SKCC. In collaboration with Homefix, we have also launched a Makerspace for residents who are keen to perform their own handyman services.

For our senior citizens, we have added an additional mobile van and now have two vans to ferry them to the polyclinic or Traditional Chinese Medicine clinic.

We are constantly helping our residents with employment opportunities within our community through the Community Employment Programme (CEP). The programmes we introduce complement CEP by creating more jobs.

We are continuously working with government agencies to improve our constituency. For transport, the Compassvale Bus Interchange has been constructed to accommodate additional services. In addition, the LRT line has been upgraded to a two-car system during peak hours. Commuters can look forward to improved barrier-free access and new dual-speed escalators leading to the MRT and LRT platforms, and an extra lift for the MRT, LRT and mezzanine levels of the Sengkang transport node. The current LRT train platform will also be expanded. The works are expected to be completed by 2022.



In addition, a new two-storey mega childcare centre at Sengkang Riverside Park has recently opened. Over the next two years, 4 more mega childcare centres will be built to meet Sengkang's growing pre-school demands. Compass One reopened its doors in 2016 and continues to cater to the retail and dining needs for our residents. The Sengkang General and Community Hospitals which opened in August 2018 is connected to Cheng Lim LRT station (one stop away from Sengkang station) for greater accessibility.

In Buangkok, plans are underway to develop an integrated community hub with a hawker centre, community club, childcare centre, retail shops as well as public rail and bus transport facilities.

We look forward to listening to your suggestions on how to improve our constituency, as we continue to strive to make Sengkang Central a home for everyone.

At Punggol East, we strive for continual improvement in our relentless pursuit for quality living for our residents.

The opening of childcare centres has eased the increasing demand for childcare places, and parents can look forward to sending their children to these facilities with a greater peace of mind. I am happy to note that two more large childcare centres will be built at Rivervale Crescent and behind Rivervale Plaza as part of the new Rivervale Community Club (CC). Looking ahead, residents can look forward to a bigger and better CC set to be ready by 2020.

Under the Bus Service Enhancement programme, more buses have been added, and the number of routes have been doubled. Waiting times and overcrowding on buses have progressively improved. New bus services 371 and 654 were also added to bring our residents to the Sengkang interchange, LRT stations, Rivervale Mall and the Central Business District seamlessly.

Improvement road works including repainting of double white lines and additional right turn lane on Buangkok East Drive (towards Sengkang East Drive), expansion of the KPE/TPE interchange for a new road connection to Punggol Central are scheduled to be completed by 2019.

Harmony Square Two was built to accommodate larger scale events such as the annual countdown party. The 70m by 40m hard court is located at the field next to Block 157A Rivervale Crescent.

The revamped Rivervale Mall now provides residents greater convenience with varied dining and retail options.

Construction of a sheltered walkway at Block 146A Rivervale Drive linking to the existing bus stop (near Rumbia LRT) was completed, thereby providing provide all-weather protection for residents.

Moving forward, our team will continue to work closely with residents to further enhance your living environment.



16 years since the first blocks were built, Punggol has transformed into a choice estate for many Singaporeans. Many residents would have celebrated their many "firsts" and milestones such as welcoming their first child, first child's birthday, and child's first day of school. Punggol West has since become a place where our residents affectionately call their home.

Punggol West will continue to be upgraded to meet your changing needs. Currently, about 14% of residents in this constituency are aged 14 years old and below. With this in mind, the Punggol West Container Library, our first temporary library, was built in 2016 at Block 211A Punggol Walk to provide a space for outside classroom learning. When Punggol Town Hub is ready in 2020, it will house our first public library alongside a community centre and a hawker centre, among other amenities.

We have also started a study corner at Block 209B Punggol Place during exam periods which provides a safe and conducive environment for our young residents.

The Punggol Temporary Bus Interchange was expanded to provide for more bus services. Following which, the Bus Service Enhancement programme was implemented to improve commuting time and connectivity, increasing convenience for residents.

While Punggol West has seen a huge transformation as compared to a decade ago, we will continue to work together to inject fresh vibrancy into our Town.
